Re: Final report, 2013 workshop, "Leave It In the Ground"

The workshop was a resounding success on several counts: all registered participants attended, everyone did the readings and were well prepared to present each other's work, the facilities and services were conducive to a focused discussion, and, best I can tell, everyone came away energized to complete their papers and get the book out.

So, re publication, we three co-PIs—Princen, Manno and Martin—met with two publishers at ISA receiving enthusiastic encouragement from both. We agreed with the chief editor from MIT Press, though, to submit the chapters we now have for a quick external review and possible advanced contract. We are assembling and editing those chapters now and expect to send them by the end of the month. Assuming the result is positive, our plan is to complete the entire manuscript by the end of the summer, submit for a full review (at the editor's suggestion) and, if all goes right, the book would come out in the fall, 2014 (after yet one more LIIG panel, this time at ISA Toronto). So all this is on track.
