

**POST WORKSHOP REPORT FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDIES ASSOCIATION
CATALYTIC RESEARCH GRANT 'CULTURAL DIVERSITY AND
INTERNATIONAL ORDER'**

Workshop summary

This workshop drew together the co-editors and several key chapter contributors to the forthcoming volume *Diversity and its Discontents: Cultural Diversity and International Order*, co-edited by Christian Reus-Smit and Andrew Phillips, and currently under contract with Cambridge University Press.

The workshop focused on further refining the book's conceptual apparatus, as outlined in a memo co-authored by Reus-Smit and Phillips, and also on critiquing and refining chapter drafts submitted by the workshop participants. The workshop also benefited from the participation of discussants both internal and external to the project, including an early career researcher (Elif Kalaycioglu) who has subsequently been recruited to contribute a chapter to the project. The workshop concluded with a discussion of plans for proceeding further with the project. As the workshop focused on production of a book manuscript that is already under contract, much of the discussion concentrated on logistical as well as substantive intellectual issues. In particular, the co-editors and chapter contributors agreed to a time-line for circulation of substantive editorial feedback for chapters presented at the workshop (delivered June 2018), as well as to deadlines for final submission of chapters (September 1 2018), as well as delivery of the completed manuscript for review to the publisher by December 1 2018.

Plans for future publications

As noted above, the workshop was oriented towards improving chapters for a book project for which the co-editors have already secured a contract with Cambridge University Press. The volume, tentatively titled *Diversity and its Discontents: Cultural Diversity and International Order*, is scheduled for delivery to CUP for review by December 1 2018, with an expected publication date by the end of 2018. We have progressed in accordance with the post-workshop timeline, and are confident of delivery of the full manuscript to the publisher by the nominated date.
